Student Supply List

2026-2027

- 6 duo-tangs (1 each of red, orange, green, yellow, grey, blue)
- 2 writing dual-pocket duotangs (pockets and prongs)
- 4pk 32pg Hilroy exercise books
- 3 Hilroy 80pg notebooks
- 1 package of graph paper (smallest amount - 20-50 pages) (Dollarstore package works!)
- 4 packages of 24 HB pencils (*please avoid Dollar Store pencils if possible*)
- 1 package of blue or black pens
- Pointed 5 inch metal children's scissors
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 packages of thick markers (Crayola washable)
- 1 package of Crayons (Crayola)
- 1 box of Pencil crayons (Crayola or Staedtler)
- 4 black sharpie markers
- 8 dry erase markers
- 4 white erasers
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 package of large or medium Ziploc bags
- 1 package of coloured or white cardstock
- 1 8.5 x 11 sketch book (Dollar Store)
- 1 container of Play-Doh (Dollar Store, used for literacy)
- 1 package of yellow sticky notes (used for literacy and math)
- 1 package of index cards
- 1 trifold (to be brought the first week of school)

For French:

- 1 yellow duotang

For Music:

- 1 pocket file folder
- Optional: noise-cancelling headphones

Students also need a change of clothing (labelled in a Ziploc bag), a lunch box, bookbag, non-marking indoor sneakers (laces only if your child can tie independently), a water bottle, and a student fee of \$30.

The student fee helps cover consumable items such as:

- supplies for experiments, crafts, and projects
- special events and curricular activities

Please do not write your child's name on supplies. Supplies will be gathered and distributed as needed in shared class bins. I also encourage students to keep any "special" supplies (decorated folders, fancy pens, etc.) at home for homework. Students should have pencils, erasers, markers, and a dice at home for homework.
